**Deadline for Entering the Philip Meyer Journalism Awards:**

Entries must be **postmarked** by **October 31, 2009**

**Entry Fees:** (Membership must be current through Nov. 1, 2009)

\$55 per entry for current IRE members

\$115 per entry for nonmembers (includes one-year IRE membership)

\$25 per entry for nonmember students (includes one-year IRE student membership)

Free for students who are current IRE members!

Fees are not refundable

**Contest Period**

All work must have been published or aired between October 1, 2008 and September 30, 2009.

**Awards:**

The awards include cash prizes: \$500 for first, \$300 for second, and \$200 for third.

**Number of Entries Allowed:**

There is no limit on the number of entries you may submit, or the number of stories (in a series) you may submit per entry.

**Entry Language:**

We accept entries in all languages but require three (3) complete hard copies of English translations for each entry.

# Entry Preparation

**Keep packets simple.** Binder clips should be used to bind your entries. All excess packaging will be discarded. All spiral bindings, 3-ring binders, notebooks, document sleeves, etc. will be removed and discarded.
