Also learn how to dig deeper using the Internet and find valuable datasets for your stories (Class size is limited; register early to reserve a seat on a first-come, first-serve basis).

Intermediate: If you can comfortably move around, write a formula and import information into a spreadsheet, this is the session for you. This hands-on workshop will help reporters use Microsoft Access to delve into databases for more in-depth stories. The session will cover searching a database, summarizing and sorting data, and importing information into a database (Class size is limited; register early to reserve a seat on a first-come, first-serve basis).
